It's been a few weeks since we touched base. Next week we move out of Level 4 and into Level 3.

We have been working hard, changing the way we bring health care to you, to keep everyone safe, and make sure your health needs are met.

What will Level 3 look like for us?

In General Practice, Level 3 will look a lot like what our current Level 4 looks like.

- We will continue to limit Face to Face consults by providing phone and virtual consultations
- The Doctors Napier, Munroe Street, will continue to run as a CBAC, so we will continue to care for you through our other clinics if you need to be seen
- All scripts will need to be sent to a pharmacy, so please have the name of the pharmacy you use when requesting a repeat prescription.
- We will continue to provide our normal services; however, this may be done in new ways for now.

Starting next week, we are able to start administering Flu Vaccinations to ALL patients. We are running a Drive-Thru clinic at our Greenmeadows Clinic, 524 Kennedy Road. This is a booked service only, so please call 06 8446277 to book your appointment.

If you are not eligible for a funded vaccination there will be a \$35 charge which will

Nurse & GP Appointments



What happens when I call for an appointment?

When you contact the practice to see the doctor or nurse the reception team will take a contact number for you, you will receive a call back from one of our GP team. Please ensure you are available on the number you have given us.

If our team are able to provide a phone consultation at the time of calling you back, they will ,or if an examination is required, they will arrange a video or face to face consultation for you.

How do I pay for my consult?

All 15-minute consultations (phone, virtual or face to face) are charged as usual.

You will receive an account via email or post with your balance – you can pay by:

- 1. Ringing the practice and paying over the phone with a Credit Card
- 2. You can do online banking; Please be sure to use your invoice number as a reference.

Napier CBAC



The Doctors Napier, 30 Munroe Street is a designated COVID-19 testing and assessment centre.

If you have a cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, fever, runny nose or sneezing please contact the Napier CBAC on 06 650 4000 to arrange an appointment to be swabbed/assessed by our friendly team.

Please be aware this testing IS BY APPOINTMENT ONLY.

COVID-19 testing is **FREE** – you will not be charged for your swab.

Changes to Driver's, ACC & MSD Certificates

Driver licences due to expire, or expired have been extended by up to six months from April 10. The changes apply to any licences that were due to expire from 1 January (unless otherwise revoked). Those drivers over 75 can continue to drive using their existing license, as the term of the licence has been deemed to have been extended until further notice.

ACC & MSD have also expanded the range of services (such as renewing certificates) that can be completed via telehealth during the COVID-19 response.
