The flu season is upon us and the Ministry of Health is strongly encouraging the <u>flu</u> <u>vaccine</u> this year.

We have had minimal exposure to flu virus with the borders shut for two years and therefore, we need to prepare for a worse than usual season.

The flu vaccine is FREE for some people who are most likely to get very sick (ages 6 months+).

- People over 65
- Māori and Pacific people over 55
- · Pregnant people
- People with underlying health conditions and aged over six months.

Self care if you have Covid

Most people with Covid are likely to have mild to moderate illness. Self-care advice is regularly updated here, and there is a handy checklist here to prepare your household before anyone has Covid.

Monitoring your symptoms

From days five to 10 of developing Covid symptoms, it can the most anxious time for breathing complications. This is more likely to occurs for older people and people with:

- · high blood pressure
- · obesity
- diabetes

It is important to monitor your symptoms and talk with your healthcare team if you have any concerns. <u>The Doctors</u> have useful information to help you manage Covid at home and keep track of your symptoms.

Call 111 if you:

- Have severe trouble breathing or severe chest pain
- Are very confused or not thinking clearly
- Feel faint or pass out (lose consciousness)



Face-to-face appointments

Consultations are available for all vaccinated and unvaccinated patients but we need to do a few things differently while Covid is in the community.

Please wear a mask at all times in our practice.

When you phone for an appointment we'll ask you if you have any <u>Covid symptoms</u>. If you do we'll ask you to:

- stay in your car or outside,
- · phone us when you arrive, and
- · wait for further instructions.


Repeat prescriptions
